



Erasmus+ Basics

Legislation:

- EU Treaty: « The Union shall contribute to the development of quality education" and "... implement a vocational training policy ..."
- **Erasmus+ Regulation** (adopted by EU Parliament and EU Council of Ministers)

Budget 2021-2027:

➤ €26.2 bn: Education, Training, Youth, Sport (70% mobility)

(adopted by EU Parliament & EU Ministers)

> €2.2 bn: International actions

"The principles of transparency, equal treatment and non-discrimination set out in the [EU] Financial Regulation should be respected in the implementation of the Programme". (Erasmus+ Regulation)


Objectives of Erasmus+ international actions
